Why E-mail Archiving is Important

In a world where more than 541 million workers rely on e-mail communications each day, more than 10,000 compliance regulations have been adopted. MarketStor's eArchiver is compliant with regulations and prepared to handle the load for your business, providing three major services.

Storage Management - With so many people using e-mail these days, it may be no surprise corporate users send and receive an average of 133 e-mail messages per day. This number is expected to reach 166 messages per day by 2009. About 97 percent of all corporate communications are now done via e-mail. The average size of a single e-mail message is 0.11 MB. Therefore the daily storage requirement for a single user is 14.7 MB, or 294 MB of information per user per month, based on 20 business days per month.

Regulatory Compliance - With thousands of regulations, including SOX, SEC, NASD and HIPAA, technologies operating with Microsoft's Exchange Server and facilitate regulatory compliance have become critical for business. Regulatory compliance is based on 1) Permanence – data must be maintained in an original and unaltered state; 2) Security – data must be safeguarded against all threats; and 3) Ability to Audit – data must be easily accessible by authorized personnel, when necessary. The MS eArchiver meets all requirements.

Litigation & eDiscovery - eDiscovery requires all parties involved in litigation to submit relevant data, stored in electronic format, in a timely manner. eDiscovery can be costly and time consuming for companies that do not have an adequate, e-mail archiving system. MS eArchiver makes litigation and eDiscovery quicker and simpler.
